Cultivate: College Experience is a one-year internship for a college student to serve in a local church or ministry setting. The intern will serve in a local community of faith for 20 hours/week from October 1, 2019 to May 1, 2020 receiving a salary of \$10,000.

Next Gen will match the student with a ministry setting and supervisor who will consider and accept the internship application. Students will be interns of the local ministry setting, not Next Generation Ministries.
